### 3. Systematic Efforts to Improve Teaching

Although I used slides and movies from time to time, since beginning teaching at UCSB in 1967, I began to do so more systematically in 1977. I have photographs made of graphs and pictures from the current literature relevant to my courses in Sexuality, Socialization, Science and Humanism, Social Organization and Pragmatism. My educational collection has grown to approximately 18,000 slides. I have obtained several grants from Instructional Development for improving my courses, adding slides, and so forth. Every year I add the maximum number of slides that I can based on the allotment from Kerr Hall Learning Services. I also cull old slides as they become outdated, so that my slide collections for all my courses are modern and up-to-date.

In 1982 I began to make videotapes for my course (the Sociology of Human Sexuality) and participate in other educational TV activities.

In 2001, with the help of funds from Letters and Science, I began to create a web site for my popular Soc 152 courses on human sexuality. I also created a new course, Soc 152C, for students who would like to participate in constructing the web site and answering questions that users send to the webmaster. The site gives a broad range of practical information about sexuality and my Soc 152A course. It also has places for students to ask questions and read the answers posted to questions that others have asked. It lists numerous links to other web sites where students can find information about sexually transmitted diseases, sexual problems, sexual assault, and much more. It is designed to be of use not only to students at University of California, Santa Barbara, but to anyone who wishes to use the web to find information about sexuality and related topics.
